Patriarch Bechara Boutros al-Rahi was elected on March 15th, 2011 as the seventy-seventh Maronite Patriarch of Antioch and the entire East. On November 24th, 2012, Pope Benedict XVI elevated him to the position of Cardinal. Pope Francis appointed him to his present position as a member in the Congregation for Catholic Education in the Vatican.
